Dear Employees of Goldsmith Williams Solicitors

We have just received your generous donation of £55.30 and I would like to say a very big thank you for your kindness and support.

In 2006 the NSPCC merged with ChildLine, the 24 hour confidential helpline for children and young people. Since then ChildLine has counselled more children for sexual abuse than at any other time; in 2007/2008 we supported 13,237 children many of whom had been mistreated by a family member, friend, or someone known to them. Although this illustrates that the awareness of our services has increased and more children have felt able to pick up the phone and tell us about their experiences, we are still unable to answer every cry for help.

In response, the NSPCC is calling on the public to donate to its Child's Voice Appeal, which launched in September 2008, and aims to raise £50m so that the NSPCC's vital Helplines can answer 500,000 more calls every year from children who suffer daily from being victims of sexual, as well as other forms of abuse.

"As a ChildLine counsellor, I have experienced first hand these heart-wrenching calls from children who feel utterly alone until they make the call, I know the hope we provide these children literally saves precious young lives."

If it wasn't for the support offered by individuals and companies like Goldsmith Williams Solicitors we would be unable to achieve this goal. I would therefore like to thank you once again, on behalf of everyone at the NSPCC and the children we help, for your commitment to ending cruelty to children.
